Water Rescue Minimum Equipment Requirements

Water Rescue Division

Awareness & Rope

- 16 pieces of ¼ “ line 5’ long

Operations

- **Per Student**
 - Helmet (top, side, back protection)
 - Type III PFD’s
 - Rescue Knife
 - Whistle
- 12 ea Throw Bags
- 8 ea Locking Carabiners
- 4 ea Small loop of webbing (for double floating line tether)
- 2 ea Ring Buoy (min 20” dia.)
- 4 ea Paddles (oars)
- Strainer

Advanced Line Systems

- **Per Student**
 - Recommended PPE dry suit or wet suit
 - Helmet
 - Type V PFD’s
- 4 (min200’) ½” static kernmantle ropes
- 1 prusik minding pulley
- 6 regular pulleys
- 12 steel carabiners or “G” rated aluminum (locking)
- Rigging plate or steel ring
- Webbing for anchors
- 4 prusik cords
(2 ea - 8’ long 8 mm and 2 ea -10’ long 8 mm)
- 6 ea 12’ to 15’ lengths of rope for dynamic ferry
- JonBoat, Inflatable, or RDC

Emergency Boat Operations

- **Per Student**
 - Recommended PPE dry suit or wet suit
 - Helmet
 - Type III PFD’s
- 3 boats and motors and fuel tanks
- Fuel (extra)
- Anchors (1 each boat)
- 2 ea - 15’ 1” webbing for flip lines
(2 per boat)
- 8 Throw bags
- Roll aboard net (or equivalent)
- Buoys (min 6 with anchors and line)
- Paddles 2 for each boat + (4 extra)

Ice Rescue

- **Per Student**
 - Drysuit or equivalent ice rescue suit per student
 - Helmet
 - Type III PFD’s
 - Appropriate cold water gloves
 - 1 ea – 10’ 1” Webbing for personal harnesses (or Type 3 harness)
 - 2 locking carabiners
 - Ice awls
- Jon Boat, Inflatable boat, or RDC
- 4 non locking carabiners
- 12 ea Throw bags
- 2 ea Ring Buoy
- 2 ea Ice staffs
- Chain saw + fuel
- Extra rope (200’)
